



Welcome to our first issue!

Some of you know us well, and some may have heard of us. For those of you who are getting to know us, we are **My Green Story foundation**.

It was formed by a group of regular people with similar concerns about the environment, climate change, pollution, rising carbon emissions, increased illnesses, drying water supplies, forest fires, and devastating impacts on our country and our planet.

The foundation works on a voluntary basis focusing on aspects causing harm and finding ways to mitigate the damages through reforestation and increasing awareness to provide comprehensive information on what can be done on individual, community, and at a national level.

With a long-term goal of planting millions of trees, we have partnered with several organizations and together we have planted **61,523 trees**. The organizations include; -

- **Big Ship CBO**

My Green Story in conjunction with Big Ship has planted **36,222 mangrove trees**. Mangroves are essential biological filters as they contribute to 7 times the carbon sequestration and storage compared to a terrestrial forest.

Mangroves provide livelihoods to adjacent communities in terms of fishing grounds, beehive farming as well as coastal tourism. Beekeeping and material recycling are also undertaken at our mangrove

site and there is a material recovery center that collects and recycles waste resources from both, the creek as well as households.

- Sai School

This program was initiated with the plantation of 3800 seedlings in October 2019. By the end of 2021 we had planted 10,000 trees and the remaining 980,000 seedlings will be planted by 2022; in phases.

- Tree for healthy community initiative program,

This is an organization that runs a program named Trees for Birthday Initiative whereby they organize monthly tree planting events in which those celebrating their birthdays in a particular month get to plant their future as they share a big green cake.

In February 2020, 200 trees were planted at the Bensophil Community School in Kawangware.
